Introduction

This Privacy Policy outlines how National Security Resource, a website operated by Vector7 Ltd (referred to as "us", "we", or "our"), collects, uses, and protects your personal data when you use our website, nationalsecurityresource.co.uk (the "Site"). We are committed to protecting your privacy and handling your data in an open and transparent manner. Information We Collect

Information Collection and Use

We use your Personal Information only for providing and improving the Site. While using our Site, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you. Personally, identifiable information may include but is not limited to your name, address, email address, and telephone number ("Personal Information").

Log Data

Like many site operators, we collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our Site ("Log Data"). This Log Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol ("IP") address, browser type, browser version, the pages of our Site that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages and other statistics.

Cookies

Cookies are files with a small amount of data, which may include an anonymous unique identifier. Cookies are sent to your browser from a website and stored on your computer's hard drive. Like many sites, we use "cookies" to collect information. You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some portions of our Site.

How We Use Your Data & Third-Party Services

Legal Basis for Processing

We will only process your personal data where we have a lawful basis to do so under the GDPR. Our legal bases include:

- **Consent:** When you give us clear consent to process your personal data for a specific purpose (e.g., signing up for a newsletter).
- **Contractual Obligation:** When the processing is necessary for a contract we have with you (e.g., to create a member account).
- **Legitimate Interests:** When the processing is necessary for our legitimate business interests, provided they do not override your fundamental rights and freedoms.

Third-Party Services We use third-party services to help us run our website and provide a better experience. These services may collect and process your data on our behalf.

- **Google AdSense:** We use Google AdSense to serve advertisements on our website. **Google uses cookies to serve ads based on your prior visits to our site and other websites.** You can opt out of personalised advertising by visiting Google's [Ads Settings](#).
- **Google Analytics:** We may use third-party services such as Google Analytics that collect, monitor and analyse this.

Communications

We may use your Personal Information to contact you with newsletters, marketing or promotional materials and other information for communication purposes only.

Data Protection and Your Rights

Security & SSL

The security of your Personal Information is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security. Our website is protected using an SSL Certificate (Secure Sockets Layer), which establishes an encrypted link between a web server and a browser. This link ensures that all data passed between the web server and browsers remain private and integral.

Your Rights Under the GDPR, you have the right to:

- **The Right to Be Informed:** You have the right to be informed about how we collect and use your personal data.
- **The Right of Access:** You can request a copy of the personal data we hold about you.
- **The Right to Rectification:** You can ask us to correct any inaccurate or incomplete data we hold about you.
- **The Right to Erasure:** You can request the deletion of your personal data in certain circumstances.

- **The Right to Restrict Processing:** You can request that we stop processing your personal data in certain circumstances.
- **The Right to Data Portability:** You can request that we transfer your data to another organisation.
- **The Right to Object:** You can object to the processing of your personal data in certain circumstances.
